Daniel “Dan” Heller, 63, of Kalkaska, passed away Friday, January 3, 2020 at home surrounded by his loving family.

Dan was born on March 3, 1956 in Detroit, Michigan, to the late Wallace and Helen (Shaffer) Heller. On June 20, 2009, Dan married Judy (Bennett) Heller.
