Elaine Marie Gaultier, 89, of South Boardman, passed away on Wednesday, May 29, 2024. She was born to Cleon and Erma (McTaggart) Brockway on December 11, 1934 in South Boardman. Elaine studied at Western Michigan University until her marriage to Gerald "Jerry" Gaultier on October 15, 1954, then followed her husband while he served in the USAF. Elaine was proud to have a part in raising 22 children, 4 of whom were her own, and then many others who needed a home for weeks, months, or some for years. She was an independent, sassy lady who loved her family dearly. She enjoyed cooking delicious meals, writing humorous poetry, painting, and gardening. She worked on the Kalkaska County Jury Board for many years.
