Treyvor, Logan, Violet, Zebastian and Xander.

Since he never much liked a crowd, there won't be any special services, but later this summer he will get his final wish when the family gets together to put his ashes in a hole out back while we remember the good ole days together such as how he loved to travel and go on camping trips. The way he made sure his kids knew their way around basic auto maintenance. How he served his country in the U.S. Army and came home to build his own home on the farmstead where he was born and raised. 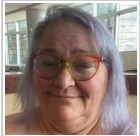
