Jack B. Weber, 88, of Kingsley, passed away on Friday, March 18, 2016 at Countryside Senior AFC. He was born on November 17, 1927 to the late Ralph and Catherine (Beaton) Weber. Jack was raised by his grandparents, the late Antone and Lena Weber, on the family farm. Jack attended schools in Summit City and Kingsley. He also did his fair share of logging and making maple syrup. Jack was a member of St. Johannes Lutheran Church in Kingsley until it closed.
