Jeremy was diagnosed with stage 4 colon cancer on September 4, 2020 and given 3 months to live at that time if he did not do chemotherapy or 2 years if he did chemo. Jeremy decided to heal his own way; his plan was to heal completely and live a long life with his wife Ania and their animals Axl and Amora, and he wanted to have a baby boy. Jeremy loved to travel, loved to talk to everyone, loved to help anyone in need, especially in the Detroit music industry and also in plumbing needs. He was a master plant grower, A Master Plumber and could fix anything in the house from the furnace, electrical problems to carpentry work; his brain was built for problem solving. He was always quick to apologize and make up and say I love you; he lived like Jesus & loved Jesus. He was an amazing Dj, and loved to bring people together with music, always thinking of the future and was so inventive with his ideas. He created a whole solar powered portable van Dj set up. With Ania, Axl & Amora, they did a van-life trip out west for three months; they traveled to Tucson, Sedona, Southern California, San Clemente, Big Sur, the redwoods, Lake Tahoe, Moab and Colorado. He was always up for an adventure.
