Lloyd Lewis Beebe, 93, of Kalkaska, passed away November 30, 2019. He was born in Kalkaska on November 18, 1926 to the late Ross and Esther (Lewis) Beebe. He married Beverly Nagy on February 23, 1950 and together they raised their six children in Kalkaska. After Beverly passed in 1997, Lloyd met and fell in love with Sally Hatley; they were married on July 3, 1998. Lloyd was a hardworking family man who was a great teacher and mentor to those whose lives he touched. He volunteered as a firefighter and served as fire chief in Kalkaska.
