Marian Edith Churchill, 97, of Kalkaska passed away peacefully on April 3, 2024 at Kalkaska Memorial Health Center - Long Term Care. She was born on August 18, 1926 in Spokane, Washington to the late Harry and Estelle (Mohre) Slocum. Marian grew up in Spokane and eventually moved to Treasure Island, CA and met Eugene Sherwood. They first moved to Norfolk, VA, and then to Michigan in 1956. They would live at various bases over the course of 42 years. After Eugene passed away in 1981, Marian eventually met and married Harold "Hal" Churchill until his death in 1991. Marian was one of the first Aides employed by Kalkaska Schools and stayed in that role for 16 years.
