October 11, 1953 - January 12, 2017

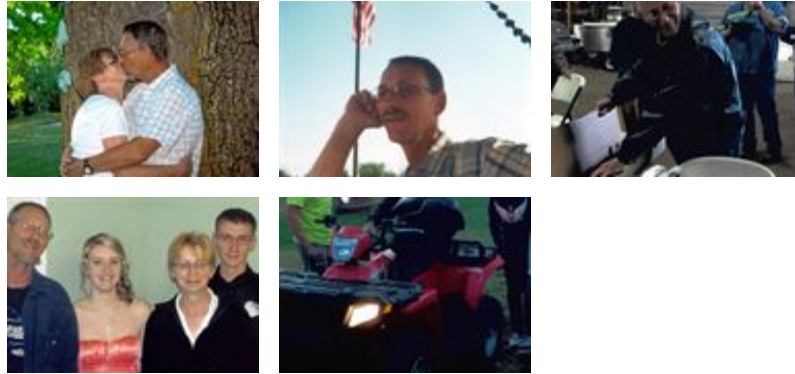
