Robert John Carey (“Bob”), 80, of Kalkaska passed away peacefully on May 7, 2024. Bob was born on October 30, 1943, in Detroit to the late John and Marian (Ryan) Carey. Bob married the love of his life Fran on April 21, 1972, in Kalamazoo, Michigan. He was a Civil War buff, was a yoyo champion, and boxed in the Golden Gloves, but Bob’s biggest accomplishment was being the proud Papa to his five grandchildren.
