SOUTH BOARDMAN – Terry L. Hart, 60, of South Boardman, passed away Thursday, February 20, 2014, with his family by his side, after a short, but brave and diligent battle with cancer.

Terry was born in Flint, MI on May 13, 1953, the son of Fred and Ellen (Howell) Hart. He married the late Gina Lucille (Chicilli) Hart on July 2, 1981, which was also Gina's 24th birthday. Together they shared over 28 years of marriage before her passing on March 21, 2010.
